

Steamboat Wharf Marina: Spring Service Check List

**See Spring Service Price Sheet for pricing and additional services offered.*

- Shrink Wrap Removal:** Remove and recycle shrink wrap and framing. If customer removes shrink wrap, all materials must be removed from premises.
- Bottom Paint**
- Wash, Compound, and Wax Hull**
- Spring Commissioning:** Normal Spring Commissioning includes: Clean all battery connections and install on battery. Charge, test, and replace batteries as needed. Visually inspect fuel system and connections. Check all fluid levels. Run engine to normal operating temperature. Check for proper operation of cooling system, ignition, and electrical systems. Check shift and throttle. Remove propeller, visually inspect, grease prop shaft, check for fishing line and gear oil leaks, and reinstall prop and hardware. Check Safety systems for proper operation: bilge pumps, NAV Lights, and horn.
- Engine Tune Up:** Outboard Engine Tune up: Remove and replace, as needed, spark plugs, and engine anodes (internal, bracket, and gear case zincs). Replace boat fuel/water separator and engine fuel filter.
- Commission Domestic & 12V Systems:** Purge antifreeze from water tanks, pumps, and lines. Flush fresh water systems such as sinks, washdowns, showers, and head systems with clean water and disinfectants as needed. Fill fresh water tanks. Test raw water and live well pumps for proper operation. Clean strainers (Water pick-ups) of debris and check ball valves for proper operation. 12V Systems. Power on all 12V Circuits. Operate all switches/accessories and test for proper operation. Note any devices not operable. Contact customer and repair as recommended.
- Zincs:** Replace boat, trim tab, and shaft zincs, as needed.
- Boat Launch:** Please select desired launch week. Boat launches typically occur on Thursday or Friday and are dependent on tides, weather, and availability of boat hauling equipment. Launches are scheduled on a first come first serve basis and busy weeks fill up. If scheduled launch is canceled, we cannot guarantee launching the following week. Non-Slip customers will be provided with 24 hours of free dockage, space permitting. If extended dockage is required arrangements must be made and will be subject to prevailing dockage rates.
